

# SPRING 2016 IN REVIEW

### 2016 Off to an Exciting Start

We have had the privilege of starting off our 21st year in the auction business with noteworthy results for outstanding works of art, exciting staff updates and expanding national office space. Significant consignments and monumental sales over the last year validate the strength of the Canadian art market, with Heffel at the forefront. We are excited to share that since the start of our fiscal year in August 2015, Heffel has sold artworks totaling more



Our semi-annual live auction held May 25, 2016 at the Vancouver Convention Centre saw strong competition for the 144 works on offer. With the help of our dedicated collectors, Heffel amassed a historically significant group of rare-to-the-market masterpieces, many of which had previously spent lifetimes in private hands. Indicative of unremitting collector demand for impressive works of art, the collection achieved a total of \$17.2 million, over and above presale estimates of \$9 to \$12 million.

Interest in and appreciation for works by Lawren Harris, a founding member of Canada's greatest national art movement, the Group of Seven, is unsurpassed. Our spring auction featured three major works by Harris, led by *Laurentian Landscape* for \$2,183,000. This 1913 – 1914 canvas is recognized as a pivotal piece from the artist's extensive career and marked a turning point in the history of the Group of Seven.

Indicative of the rich history represented in the spring auction was a remarkable postwar canvas by E.J. Hughes, who was an official Canadian war artist in World War II. *The Post Office at Courtenay*, *BC* garnered major interest that drove the work past the million dollar mark to set a new record for the artist at \$1,593,000.

We are also delighted with the results generated from Heffel's online auction platform since the start of the new year. We saw enthusiastic online bidding from collectors across

# Six Artist Records Shattered at Live Auction

Spirited bidding propelled works by six artists to record-breaking results at our Spring live auction on May 25. Noteworthy artist records from the auction were achieved with E.J. Hughes's remarkable post-war canvas, *The Post Office at Courtenay*, *BC* and Guido Molinari's commanding *Sans titre*. Important West Coast artists also saw new records, including W.P. Weston with *Mt. Klitsa* and Takao Tanabe with *Goletas Channel* 1/86.

We are excited about this change and look forward to enjoying the new space with all of you.

### Handling Corporate Collections

Following last year's successful partnership with Imperial Oil Limited to help sell works from their collection, April 2016 marked the start of the second series of HO2 online auctions with works from the important collection of BP Canada in Calgary. The monthly online auctions featured approximately 75 lots per sale and partial consignor proceeds will be donated to local charities.
