

Betty Goodwin's very first Vest print was created in August 1969, and according to the artist it was "the true beginning of her career". Indeed, this series is extremely significant in her work and she had a deep, intimate connection to the subject as her father, who passed when she was very young, was a tailor. Indeed, this elegant print is imbued with sensitivity and solemnity. Vest Two was created 6 months later, in January 1970. State 1 (of which this print is part of) were etched in January 1970, and printed in March; State 2 were printed in 1971 and have a japan paper laminate "colouring" on the right half of the vest. Goodwin's studio notes indicate that artist Yves Gaucher – who was her printmaking professor at Sir George Williams University, today Concordia University – was very impressed by the velvety finish of the black pigments used in this work. There are 3 artist's proofs and the edition is out of 10.

Upon Jack Shadbolt's homecoming to Vancouver from London, England in September 1945, he commenced working on The Canadian Scene series, a series that reaffirmed his dedication to social realism of the West Coast. These watercolours from the fall of 1945 and 1946 demonstrate his affection for the old structures which shaped historic British Columbia. He depicted fishing docks on the Fraser River, False Creek industrial sites, old houses in Vancouver's West End and, here, an old church in Lytton in BC's Fraser Canyon. His interest was in more than architectural detail; he wanted to show these buildings as a reflection of society, infused with sentient feeling. Intriguingly, Shadbolt contrasts the pure, white and carefully constructed church with the wildness of the tangle of forest pressing toward the path to its door.



"Stove" demonstrates Pratt's fascination with the smooth surface quality of photographs, combined with her obsession of how lighting affected domestic space. In 1969, Pratt used photographs as a preliminary stage for all of her artworks. Evident by her works which followed, this year marks a key moment in Pratt's career -- when she fully delved into Realism. The colours of the composition represent her method of working, where she established the variations in tone rather than matching the hues exactly. As demonstrated

by the intriguing depth in space and shadows, Pratt's interest in the everyday went beyond other New Realist artists who simply recreated the "presence" of banal reality, through depicting the piercing awareness of the scene and portraying a sensual quality that excited her not only as a visual experience, but also as a representation of an event that had occurred.

The theme of the small Ontario town was an important part of A.J. Casson's oeuvre, and it distinguished him among his fellow Group of Seven members. In 1926 Casson bought his first car, a turquoise Willys Overland Whippet, which enabled his extensive explorations of Ontario's rural countryside and towns. Little Current is located on the north shore of Manitoulin Island – first settled in the late 1860s, it became a significant Great Lakes port, serving the lumber industry and attracting tourists with its picturesque setting. This is an outstanding town scene, in which Casson built up layers of buildings with an eye for geometric patterns, from the flat planes of the house walls to the squares and rectangles of windows. Casson's fine eye for composition and symmetry is in evidence – he leads the viewer from the lakefront with the road that swings up through the town, then from the rooftops to the sky. His awareness of atmosphere is fully present in his depiction of the moody weather he was so attracted to and the illumination that highlights the buildings at the lake's edge.

In 1900, artist Horatio Walker invited Clarence Gagnon to visit his studio on Île d'Orléans. It was Gagnon's first sight of this island in the St. Lawrence River with its "small woods, rustic buildings of French inspiration and villages clustered around silver church spires," as described by Hélène Sicotte. In this large and impressive painting can be seen an echo of the Barbizon and Hague School painters that influenced Canadian artists at the turn of the twentieth century with their dark palette and depictions of rural working people. Gagnon's use of light is dramatic—earthy brown and green hues are backlit by a radiant pale blue sky, and the foreground glows with warm oranges. Gagnon includes the unique structures of traditional Quebec farms, such as the snake fence and thatch roof. The farmer and his horse and cart exude the peaceful atmosphere of their well-ordered life on Île d'Orléans, and this ambience demonstrates Gagnon's great warmth of feeling for this charming painting place.

From 1951 to 1968, Arthur Lismer traveled almost every summer to Vancouver Island to paint. Lismer delighted in the jungle-like rain forest and the seacoast, with its tidal pools and shore edges full of flotsam and jetsam, flung up by the ceaseless pounding of the Pacific. He found the tumble of shells, seaweed and rock a fine subject for natural still lifes such as Long Beach, Vancouver Island. Lismer's interest in this theme had its roots in his earlier forest floor works from Georgian Bay, and his dock and shore still lifes from Nova Scotia. In his West Coast works, Lismer's use of paint exuded a raw vitality. As Dennis Reid wrote, "That this pushing of the material characteristics of paint to yet new heights of extravagant texture, rough, crude forms, and the extremes of tone and hue was a direct response to the west coast environment there can be no doubt." In Long Beach, Vancouver Island, Lismer has scratched into the richly layered surface with the tip of his brush, adding to the dynamism of this bright and vibrant work.

Edwin Holgate visited the township of Natashquan, on the north shore of the Jacques Cartier Strait on the Gulf of Saint Lawrence, in 1930 and 1932. In 1930 he was on his way to Labrador when he first stopped at this traditional Acadian fishing village, which was founded in 1855. In Sheds at Natashquan Holgate has captured the simple, distinctive buildings of this area - called the magasins du Galet - which were built specifically to prepare the fish caught in the Gulf, which were abundant at that time. The magasins du Galet are now a historic site, and look much the same as they did when Holgate painted them in the 1930s. In this richly atmospheric work, seabirds soar overhead against a moody sky, contrasted by the mix of colourful and bright white structures and the rich green of the grassy, rolling ground. Holgate's brushwork is bold and assured, giving a sense of solidity to the structures and the landscape they are a part of.

William Blair Bruce met and married the Swedish sculptor, Carolina Benedicks, in 1888 while on his return to Paris. The young couple subsequently spent their summers in Sweden, eventually establishing an artists' colony in Gotland. In 1896, the Swedish Tourist Association organized an expedition to experience the August 9th total solar eclipse in the north of Sweden. William and Caroline were among the 13 hardy participants who were housed in a cottage built in 1890 which is still in use near the waterfall site. In May of 1897, the Swedish Arts Association hosted an exhibition of 130 of Bruce's paintings including 35 works based on the solar eclipse expedition. It is very likely that The Stora Sjofallet Waterfall was included in that exhibition.

Susanna Carlston, Chief Curator of the Brucebo Foundation in Gotland confirms that there are approximately 40 Bruce sketches from the Lappland trip in their collection.



Jean Royer quoted curator and writer Jean-René Ostiguy on the significance of Marc-Aurèle Fortin's work: "Some artists succeed in revealing some of man's most profound thoughts through the simplest and most familiar visual data, by depicting everyday life in a particular geographic and sociological environment. In Canada, Marc-Aurèle Fortin's great talent lay in imbuing the urban and rural landscapes of Quebec with precious secrets, revealing a mind at once innocent and smiling, dreaming and fully human."

Fortin depicted urban harbour scenes in Montreal and rural ones in Quebec locations such as Grande-Baie and Longueuil. In 1948, the artist moved back to his childhood home of Sainte-Rose, and at that time he began to paint with casein. In this beautiful and lushly painted work, Fortin has instilled a tremendous sense of atmosphere. The sails of the boats are up, but the winds are gentle, as the boats seem to hover or glide across the water's surface, barely breaking its reflected patterns of dappled light. Above, cumulus cloud formations hang in the sky, adding to the dreamy ambiance of the scene. Fortin's brushwork boldly defines space and light through simplified strokes of both warm and cool hues. From November of 1933 to March of 1934, Marc-Aurèle Fortin was in France. He had always desired to travel there, and was finally able to do so when he received an inheritance from his father. While in Paris he visited museums and galleries, but as Hughes de Jouvancourt wrote, "his stay had convinced him that he was totally opposed to non-figurative and abstract painting," confirming his dedication to his own approach. He toured the French countryside, seeing Brittany, Normandy, Provence and the Côte d'Azur. This harbour scene in the Côte d'Azur bustles with activity – fishermen deal with the catch, and boats fill the harbour, some with distinctive triangular sails. The spire of the building in the background touches the top of the canvas, bringing the eye to the glowing lemon-coloured sky, then back down to its reflection in the water, which lights up the centre of the painting. Fortin's use of form is strongly defined, and his sense of volume defines the scene with great assurance.

During World War I, Beatty was one of the first four official Canadian War Artists appointed by the Canadian War Memorials Fund. The other three were Frederick Varley, Maurice Cullen and Charles Simpson, each of whom were given the rank of captain and full military pay. After some time languishing in the Whitby base near Toronto, Beatty was shipped overseas to France along with Cullen. Often working under German fire, they sketched at the Canadian front, depicting "...the horror, the honour and the humanity of the battlefield..." The brochure for the 2000 – 2003 Battle Lines touring show states: "This exhibition marks the first time that a substantial group of these artists' sketches have been seen together. 



This collection is from the Estate of Percival Price, the legendary Canadian-born campanologist, carillonneur, composer, author and teacher. Price was born in Toronto in 1901. He came from a musical family but it was a trip to Europe that introduced him to the art and science of bells, and in 1921 he was appointed the first carillonneur in North America at the Metropolitan Church in Toronto. Subsequently he helped with the design of the new carillon in the Peace Tower in Ottawa and held the position of Dominion Carillonneur from 1927 until 1939, when he left Canada to teach composition and campanology at Ann Arbor, University of Michigan.

During and just after World War II he served as consultant to the Inter-Allied Commission on the Wartime Preservation of Artistic and Historic Monuments in War Areas, and he helped many European countries to locate bells which had been looted for war purposes.

A collection of artifacts from his estate was donated to the National Library of Canada and forms one of the largest collections on campanology in the world. The library files also include correspondence between Price and Varley from 1941 to 1955.
