

Desiring to follow his own artistic path, Frank Johnston formally left the Group of Seven in 1924. A few years later, after consulting a numerologist, he changed his first name by taking elements from Frank and Hans to form Franz, which was deemed to be more harmonious and served to denote his new path as an artist. Johnston had worked as a commercial designer early in his career and had a finely developed sense of composition, choosing scenes with a sense of their inherent balance and beauty. Some of his best work was done in winter in northern Ontario, and he became renowned for his exquisite effects of light and snow in these scenes, such as in this striking woodland view. Snow on the banks of the stream is lit up by rays of sun, creating a fine contrast between the dazzling highlights and the shadowed snow full of delicate, luminous blues, greens and mauves, as well as the dark, slow-moving stream. Johnston adds to the effect with shimmering reflections across the surface of the water, and the result is an aesthetic delight.

This copper was commissioned in 1979 through Eagle Down Gallery in Edmonton, Alberta. It was only the second copper Vickers ever made, the first being a commission for the National Museum of Ethnology in Osaka, Japan. The title of the copper, Blackfish, is Vickers' family crest and one of the four main crests of the Coast Tsimshian. The four men on the base of the piece represent the four generations that Coppers had been in use on the North West Coast. Traditionally, coppers were valuable possessions and displays of wealth. Each time a copper was traded or sold, it's value increased at least double-fold. Individual coppers were named and their histories were well known. Vickers named this piece only after he had completed it in 1981.




