

When Eugène Boudin's father, a harbour pilot, retired from the sea to sell art supplies and picture frames in northern France, Boudin also abandoned his plans to become a captain and went to work with him. Through their shop he met Barbizon master Jean-François Millet, who saw his interest in art and encouraged him to pursue painting. Boudin followed Millet's advice and traveled to Paris, where he trained at the Louvre. As his skills developed, Boudin began to exhibit his work and to associate with other artists, meeting the Dutch painter Johan Jongkind who taught him the importance of painting out-of-doors. In 1857 Boudin met a young Claude Monet, and passed this habit on to him, becoming a singular influence in Monet's life. Boudin traveled extensively and when at home painted primarily in northern France, never losing interest in the sea - harbours and boats as subjects form a large part of his oeuvre. Due to his influence on Monet, Boudin is considered instrumental in the development of Impressionism. He participated in the first Impressionist exhibition in 1874, but also continued to show at the annual Paris salons. His masterpiece On the Beach, Sunset, from 1865 is in the collection of the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York.



Liz Taylor was one of the great icons of the film world, and was a friend of Andy Warhol's in the 1970s and 1980s. Fascinated with the cult of celebrity, Warhol moved in their circles, and became one himself. Warhol was intrigued with the power of the feminine, and Taylor, with her charisma, extravagance and resilience, was a fascinating embodiment of it. Jerry Saltz wrote: "Andy loved women and the power of the feminine, and the women he loved most and best were Marilyn, Jackie and Liz. Many of the paintings made in his heyday, between 1962 and 1965, were of them. Like the women themselves, the pictures of Liz exude a primitive hit of graphic power, stunning color, seething glamour, repressed sexuality and flawed beauty."

As he had done with Marilyn Monroe, Andy Warhol produced both paintings and prints of Taylor - in 1963, he painted a series of 13 works of her, and in all, made over 50 portraits, ranging in image from her child-actress appearance in National Velvet to her screen goddess incarnation in Cleopatra, and from his own photographs. This powerful print, with its saturated colour contrasts dominated by the red background and her ruby lips, embodies Tayor's sensuality and strength.



This lot is comprised of 38 watercolour reproductions in an edition of 300, numbered and initialed by the Fine Art Society. The reproductions were produced in Paris by Henri Piazza for London's Fine Art Society using collotype and pochoir, a method which involved the application of layers of hand-coloured stenciling to a black-and-white collotype photographic print. This lot also includes the original publisher's leather and cloth clamshell case measuring 17 3/4 x 13 3/4 x 4 1/2 inches, as well as a separate introductory booklet written by Georgiana Burne-Jones bound in green cloth, measuring 13 x 10 x 1/8 inches. All 38 reproductions have been removed from the boxed edition and framed. There are perhaps few copies which include the loose plates, making this edition particularly rare. Pre-Raphaelite artist Edward Burne-Jones (1833 - 1898) worked on this watercolour series between 1882 and 1898. Despite its name, the 38 compositions included in The Flower Book are not of the flowers themselves, but rather of subjects suggested by their names. Burne-Jones called them "a series of illustrations to the Names of Flowers." He painted the watercolours for his private pleasure, mostly during the summers he spent in Rottingdean. The series became available to the public once his widow, Georgiana, decided to publish limited edition high-quality reproduction prints of the original watercolours in 1905.
