


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

By his mid-30s Ronald Bloore had achieved an estimable reputation as a scholar, museum director, educator and founding member of the Regina Five group of painters. His work had been acquired by the National Gallery of Canada as well as by private collectors, and he had represented Canada at the Bienal de São Paulo. Yet Bloore did not have his first solo exhibition until 1962, at Dorothy Cameron's Here and Now Gallery in Toronto. In a glowing review of that show, Robert Fulford described the works in words that stand the test of time: "With the greatest possible economy...Bloore's paintings achieve a classic elegance, commanding the walls on which they hang, filling the gallery with a unique strength. They have tension, grace and an exciting sense of urgency." The following year, time spent exploring Greece, Turkey, Egypt and Spain informed Bloore's palette and schemata thereafter, beginning with his near-white paintings in raised relief from 1963 to 1966, which incorporated cross-like and circular forms based on motifs from Byzantine, Sumerian and Egyptian art. Painting No. 9 is an exemplary example from this period.

This untitled painting typifies Jean McEwen's paintings produced between 1965 and 1969. Already committed to pure abstract works in oils, McEwen set out to further test and explore the effects of what he referred to as pure colour by painting a series of images that were his unique take on the hard-edge works being produced by many of his contemporaries. In doing so, McEwen's natural instinct was to go beyond the theoretical definitions of hard edge painting by featuring a clearly outlined column of strong colour with contrasting colour bands that incorporated the gestural textures he had previously used. In this lot, McEwen's use of colour is bold and utterly original. Please note: this work is unframed.

Jock Macdonald worked in two directions in his oeuvre—landscape and abstraction—although as time progressed, abstraction dominated. His first abstractions, which he called "modalities," emerged in the mid-1930s and were extrapolated from natural forms. In the mid-1940s through 1950, he was working in a surrealist style, accessing his unconscious through the process of automatism, and using complicated patterning and biomorphic form. By the early 1950s, Macdonald was again transforming and searching for a new freedom. He moved to Toronto and became a member of Painters Eleven, a group of abstract painters who formed in 1953, declaring, "There is none so alive, creatively forceful or as talented as the members of Painters XI." In By the Sea we still see recognizable elements, such as the hand reaching from the form on the right, but the work is primarily about colour and two-dimensional space. Dynamic and playful, its black abstracted figures float at the surface over flat, brilliant planes of colour, with areas of white creating light. By the Sea is an outstanding work from this pioneer of automatic and abstract painting in Canada.



This vibrant painting is from Takao Tanabe's series The White Paintings - a theme begun when he was in England from 1953 to 1955, continued in Winnipeg in 1955 and ending in Vancouver in 1958. In this series Tanabe departed from the kind of Cubist-based, push-pull structure he had adopted while in New York in the early 1950s, instead painting in a calligraphic style, which he described as "a kind of writing hieroglyphics." His approach was fluid and organic, using hooked, semicircular and boomerang-like forms either rising above or submerging into white backgrounds. Tanabe's work was part of the wave of lyrical abstraction taking place on the West Coast in the late 1950s, along with work by artists such as Gordon Smith and Jack Shadbolt. Tanabe often gave works from this series landscape-based associative titles, and fellow artist Joe Plaskett claimed that these works were derived from Tanabe's watercolours of dunes on the coast of Denmark in 1954. Reflections at Dawn is a strong example from this series, active with gestural strokes and shapes, and dominated by a sunny yellow that exudes even more light than the white background.

Fernand Leduc was one of the linking members that facilitated a transition between the Automatist and Plasticien movements in Quebec. An important artist for numerous reasons, Leduc was able to approach and unify critical themes in art abstraction that had yet to be tackled by the Automatists. The geometric style of Leduc's painting was a break from the automatic painting style that his contemporaries such as Paul-Émile Borduas were fashioning. Chromatisme binaire: violet cobalt is a product of Leduc's second period in Paris, where the influence of painter Jean Bazaine, for whom Automatist painting techniques developed from automatic writing had reached an impasse, can be seen. A key approach Bazaine espoused was the reconciliation of the experiments of modern art and Cubism with Thomist philosophy based on the teachings of Thomas Aquinas. As Denise LeClerc writes, "Leduc, a former seminarian with a philosophical bent, found himself on familiar ground here." In this richly hued painting, Leduc has progressed to a more hard-edge style of abstraction, as seen in the linear shape of the light purple crescent contrasted against the dark, expansive background.

Jack Shadbolt's contribution to Canadian art is immeasurable, particularly in his home province of British Columbia, where he taught and mentored both his contemporaries and a younger generation of artists. He painted prolifically until his death in 1998, exploring the brighter and the darker side of our world. This included a period of work as an official Canadian War Memorials artist, a time that profoundly affected him. His work in the vein of lyrical abstraction employs vivid colour and often contains abstracted imagery drawn from the natural world, West Coast subjects and symbolic objects such as flags and masks. His expressive use of these abstracted forms rests on a solid foundation of rhythmic and colouristic relationships, resulting in harmonious works that are often a joyous riot of colour. The vibrant, contrasting colour palette and melodious composition of Above the Bay - Equivalent for Landscape vividly and masterfully exemplifies such renowned characteristics.

Boatyard was painted circa early to mid-1940s, a time of transition both artistically and personally for Sybil Andrews. During World War II, Andrews stopped producing linocuts and moved out of London, taking a job in 1942 with the British Power Boat Company at Hythe near Southampton. During this period Andrews created a small group of oil paintings of this subject, such as Boatyard. In the process of creating these unique oils, Andrews made preliminary sketches of the shipyard. Andrews explained, "I wrote to Colonel Searle, who was then head of the firm.....I said who I was, where trained, where exhibited etc., and said what a pity it was that no record could be made of the work going on, of the boats being built and I asked if I could be given permission to make notes of the composition etc. for me to work on after the war, and to my astonishment I was given authority to make sketches. So I had my little notebook in the pocket of my overalls, and was able to make quick sketches of what I wanted." Although it is not known how many oils she produced, Michael Parkin and Denise Hooker commented that "After the war Sybil made use of these sketches in a series of seven canvases which can now be seen in the R.A.F. Museum in Hendon." Boatyard is a testament to Andrews's ability with color modeling and her strong sense of composition, developed during the innovative period when she was involved with the Grosvenor School of Modern Art between 1925 and the late 1930s. Boatyard showcases Andrews's skill with oil paint, exhibiting exceptionally nuanced brushwork. It is a fine and rare example of her work on canvas. After immigrating to Canada in 1947, Andrews returned to linocuts as her primary mode of artistic expression in 1951, and in that same year became a member of the Society of Canadian Painters-Etchers and Engravers.

BGL is a Quebec City based art collective founded in the late 1990s by Jasmin Bilodeau, Sébastien Giguère and Nicolas Laverdière. 

An artist and an intellectual, Guido Molinari established himself as one of the leading figures in abstract art in Canada. The most important architect to emerge from the West Coast, Arthur Erickson was renowned nationally and internationally. With public projects such as the Simon Fraser University complex in 1963, the Museum of Anthropology in 1976 and Robson Square Courthouse in 1978, his designs have shaped the city of Vancouver. His reductive concrete landscapes, monolithic sense of space and the responsiveness of his buildings to their site in the magnificent West Coast setting have become part of our identity. As Erickson stated, "The essence of architecture is in the dialogue wrought by bringing a building and its setting into conversation."

Born in Vancouver into a cultural family, Erickson drew and painted as a young person. He forged associations with artists starting at the age of 15, when he drew the attention of Group of Seven painter Lawren Harris, who introduced him to a circle of artistic, progressive thinkers. Here, Erickson was exposed to a transcendent view of the relationship between art and the moods and feelings of nature. His connections with the art world would last throughout his life.

Erickson followed his education at McGill University with a trip through Europe on a scholarship, and through exposure to the architecture of many cultures, his world view began to form. "I am a Canadian, open to the broad world, and my work draws on universal sources to make a cultural mesh," he asserted. His projects stretched across Canada, such as the Canadian Pavilion at Montreal's Expo 67, and internationally to locations in the United States (notably the Canadian Embassy in Washington, DC which includes the work of Gordon Smith and Bill Reid), Japan (notably the World's Fairs in Tokyo and Osaka) and major projects in England, the United Arab Emirates, and Kuwait.

Erickson had personal associations with most of the artists who are represented in his estate and his family's collections. In 1964, Erickson designed the house of Gordon and Marion Smith, who became life-long friends, on a beautiful site in West Vancouver looking seaward over a park. His modernist approach to architecture was a harmonic link with Smith's modernist approach to art. Erickson took a drawing course from B.C. Binning, and greatly valued his long association with him. Binning had begun his teaching career in architecture at the University of British Columbia, and he also shared a modernist aesthetic with Erickson. In 1961, Erickson visited Japan, a trip that profoundly affected his sense of design and use of materials.

The Erickson Massey offices from about 1963 to 1965 were in Heffel's current building at 2247 Granville Street, Vancouver, during a period when Erickson produced some of his most renowned modernist designs, such as Simon Fraser University.



John Snow was born in Vancouver and lived and worked in Calgary for almost 70 years. Known as a pioneering printmaker who started the first fine art lithographic press studio in Calgary, he was also a painter and sculptor. His extensive body of work is well-known in Calgary, where his vibrant prints grace numerous public and private collections including the Nickle Galleries at the University of Calgary, which has a complete set of his lithographs.

Snow worked as a banker for most of his life, but was deeply interested in art. He was part of a family that included artists and that exposed him to fine art often in his youth, and he began his art career as a watercolour painter. With the outbreak of World War II, he enlisted with the Canadian Air Force and trained as a navigator, and was eventually posted with the Royal Air Force in Gibraltar, where he dropped supplies via paratroopers to various locations in Europe. His work as a map reader and navigator forced him to observe the land below him in a unique manner that would later influence his sense of spatial relations in his prints.

Upon his return to Canada, Snow was eager to become an artist and took a life drawing class at the Provincial Institute of Technology and Arts - then called The Tech - now the Alberta College of Art and Design (ACAD). The class was taught by Calgary modernist painter Maxwell Bates, who had spent five years in a POW camp in Germany. Bates had explored abstraction in Calgary as early as 1928 and his experiences as a prisoner-of-war led to an interest in a style of expressionism heavily influenced by Max Beckmann, whom Bates studied under at the Brooklyn Museum Art School. Bates introduced Snow to printmaking via the woodcut, and in this medium the influence of Beckmann can be seen. Bates and Snow would work together for years, influencing each other strongly. They worked side-by-side, sometimes pulling prints from stones which Snow had discovered abandoned in the alley behind Western Printing and Lithography, a Calgary firm that was upgrading to more modern equipment. Along with the stones, Snow found parts of a press, which he gathered and put back together, eventually purchasing more parts from the same company.

Snow worked tirelessly to promote art in Calgary. He became a technical expert on the lithographic press, hand-pulling each of his prints. He also interested people into his studio to observe and learn from him. He was adamant in his championship of the fine art print, praising not only its quality, but its affordability. Snow wanted people of modest means to be able to acquire fine art. Landscape, the figure, abstract forms and the still life all appear in Snow's prints. He was known to experiment with modern materials, especially in the 1970s, using plastic doilies, nylon fabric and other types of synthetic cloth to impose pattern over form in his work. Prints of this type speak uniquely of their time, and echo the influx of cheaply made plastics into modern life. Snow's dislike of the limelight has resulted in his low profile, but his prints speak for themselves, marking him as a significant figure in the world of Canadian fine art prints.
