It is with great pleasure that Heffel presents the online auction, "Gallery Moos: Selected Works from the Estate." Founded by Walter Moos in 1959, Gallery Moos was a fixture of Toronto's cultural scene, a leader in the Canadian art market, and one of the first internationally-oriented private galleries in the city. Moos held pivotal exhibitions for budding artists, promoting some of the most prominent names in Canada and abroad, including Sorel Etrog, Gershon Iskowitz, Alex Janvier, Lester Johnson, Jean Paul Riopelle, Antoni Tàpies and more. These notable artists and many others are featured in this exciting sale, which runs from October 28 through November 12.

The purchase price shall be the Hammer Price plus the Buyer's Premium calculated at a rate of twenty-five percent (25%) of the Hammer Price of the Lot up to and including \$25,000; plus twenty percent (20%) on the part of the Hammer Price over \$25,000 and up to and including \$5,000,000; plus fifteen percent (15%) on the part of the Hammer Price over \$5,000,000, plus applicable Sales Tax.

All purchases must be paid for in-full prior in order to be released to the shipper, purchaser or authorized third party.

Once the purchase has been paid in-full, the Buyer may collect their purchase from Heffel Gallery **by appointment only**.
