

Marcelle Ferron trained in Quebec City under Jean Paul Lemieux, but left the École des beaux-arts de Montréal as a result of her refusal to adhere to traditional subjects and methods. Her experimental inclinations resonated with Paul-Émile Borduas, and she became his student at l'École du meuble. Under Borduas's mentorship, Ferron forged her own personal, vibrant vision in abstraction. She was a signatory of the historic Automatist manifesto Refus global in 1948 and exhibited with this ground-breaking group. In 1953 Ferron settled in the creative hub of Paris for 13 years. This canvas is from that period in which her work is characterized by an exhilarating freedom of expression. The sweep of her palette knife manipulating broad swathes of paint across the canvas is bold and the layering creates a dimensional effect. Her use of a light background opens the work spatially and gives contrast to the rich palette of blue, black, green and yellow. Ferron's work is in the collections of major museums in Canada such as the National Gallery of Canada, and internationally, in the Museum of Modern Art in Sao Paulo, Amsterdam's Stedelijk Museum and the Hirshhorn Museum in Washington, DC.





Bill Reid first studied European jewellery techniques at Toronto's Ryerson Institute of Technology, followed by an apprenticeship in a platinum and diamond workshop. On his return to Vancouver, while still working for the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation, he made jewellery in his home studio. His return to the coast stimulated his interest in his Haida ancestry and its art, and he applied his modern knowledge and fine craftsmanship to the expression of Haida designs in gold and silver. Reid was inspired by the masterful work of Charles Edenshaw, and some of his brooches were derived from images of tattoo marks drawn by Edenshaw and John Wi'ha. In 1962 he started his own jewellery business, producing many fine works, such as the 1971 Gold Box with a three-dimensional killer whale on its lid, in the collection of the Royal BC Museum. The killer whale was an important figure to Reid, who produced a number of images of it, including the monumental bronze sculpture Killer Whale, in the collection of the Vancouver Public Aquarium. Reid's early work in gold is superb, and this exquisite 1966 killer whale brooch, produced using repoussé and texturing, is a stunning example. This work will be included in the forthcoming catalogue raisonné on the artist's work compiled by Dr. Martine Reid, Researcher and Honourary Chair, Bill Reid Foundation.

Before the Group of Seven was established, some painters had already begun to break the domination of European painting and to paint Canada in a new way – and J.W. Beatty was one of them. Although he spent two years studying abroad starting in 1906 in Paris, then in London, when he returned to Toronto in 1908 he felt such a surge of nationalism for Canada that he declared, "The future of this country stands for more than that of any country on earth." Such nationalism was in the air at the time, particularly amongst the future Group members that he met at the Arts and Letters Club in Toronto. As early as 1902 he sketched with Lawren Harris in the northern Ontario wilderness, and he was a part of a number of other early painting trips to locations such as Algonquin Park. In the 1920s, Beatty was teaching at the Ontario College of Art's Summer School while continuing to paint the Ontario countryside, such as in this peaceful and atmospheric work. Beatty's viewpoint creates the feeling of being sheltered within the forest grove while contemplating the beauty of the sunlit screen of trees glowing with fall hues against the lake and hillside beyond.

Among the Group of Seven members, A.J. Casson was best known for his depictions of the rural landscapes and villages of Ontario. In 1958 Casson left his commercial design job at Sampson Matthews Limited to paint full-time and work on expanding his already considerable artistic profile. He formed a relationship with Toronto's Roberts Gallery, and in November of 1968, the year after this work was painted, collectors lined up all day in the cold for the opening of Casson's exhibition. To Casson's astonishment, there was a melee as collectors rushed to acquire the works as the show quickly sold out.

The location of this striking painting is Pointe-au-Baril, on the east coast of Georgian Bay. A favourite painting place for other Group members as well, Georgian Bay was an area known for its strong Canadian Shield rock formations, a motif Casson was drawn to in his paintings. In Rugged Country, Casson showed his fine-tuned awareness of design elements by attracting the viewer's eye first to the top of the rocky headland emerging from lush green forest, then to the distinctive clouds which roll up behind them and soar upwards.

An early exponent of Canadian modernism, Emily Coonan first took art classes at Conseil des arts et manufactures, but her formative studies were later at the Art Association of Montreal. During this time, William Brymner became her teacher and, with his encouragement, Coonan and fellow artist Henrietta Mabel May traveled to France, Belgium and Holland in 1912. This trip allowed Coonan to see the work of the French Impressionists and greatly expanded her artistic horizons. She returned to France in 1920, enabled by a traveling grant awarded by the National Gallery of Canada. This trip proved to be significant, and subsequently her work began to indicate modernist sensibilities through increasingly simplified portraits and landscapes. Also in 1920, she became a member of the important Beaver Hall Group, and exhibited regularly at the Art Association of Montreal and the Royal Canadian Academy. Coonan frequently traveled to the Quebec countryside to paint en plein air, and this work illustrates her clear admiration of her surroundings. With its harmonious colour palette and simplified forms, Quebec Landscape is a charming work from this important female modernist.

This fine work was painted while Frank Johnston was still a member of the Group of Seven. It is the kind of classic panoramic view favoured by the Group, here sweeping over an expanse of water and strips of wooded land and distant hills up into a cloud-filled sky. A sense of elemental exhilaration in the depiction of wild landscapes had been forged during sketching trips such as the Group boxcar trips to Algoma, which Johnston took part in during 1918, 1919 and 1920. In 1921, Johnston left Toronto for Winnipeg to take a dual position as the principal of the city's school of art and director of its art gallery. He continued to paint, spending summers sketching at such locations as Lake of the Woods and Lake Manitoba. Johnston had a fine eye for the effects of light, as seen in this sublime oil. As indicated by the title of the work, Johnston has caught the light at the turn into early evening, as the landscape cools into blues and purples, but still retains the sun's warmth reflected in the clouds.

While staying at Dart's Lake in New York, David Milne was offered the use of a cottage at Mount Riga, south of Boston Corners. Part of the deal was that Milne would carry out repairs on the cottage, and this image is of the rebuilding of the porch. The catalogue raisonné indicates the date of origin of this image as October 22, 1922, when he executed Building the Porch I. He then worked on this version from February into April of 1923. At this time, Milne was exploring reduction in his images. In Building the Porch III, it is astonishing what he evokes with simple lines, a carefully limited palette of brown, orange and green accentuated with black, and sections of unpainted ground that create the awareness of open space. Milne's all-important lines are composed of several different strands of colour entwined together. In Building the Porch III, Milne takes the everyday and makes it extraordinary by evoking every element important in the scene through minimal means.

Frederick Varley moved to Vancouver in 1926 to take a teaching position at the Vancouver School of Decorative and Applied Arts. During this time, Varley painted on weekends and holidays at Garibaldi and on the North Shore mountains. As with his fellow Group of Seven painters, Varley was an outdoorsman, undeterred by the hardships of hiking and camping. In 1933 he and fellow painter Jock Macdonald founded the British Columbia College of Arts, which, although successful in attracting students, collapsed financially in the spring of 1935. Although this left Varley in difficult financial straits, he was free to paint – and he moved in this same year to a small house in Lynn Valley on the North Shore below Mt. Seymour. While in Lynn Valley during these years, as Christopher Varley relates, his natural surroundings "enchanted him", and he did some extraordinary paintings while there. The Edmonton Art Gallery catalogue assigned a circa date from this time period to this work of 1935 to 1937, due to its vivid nature.

This striking work radiates vitality. Vigorous brush-strokes depict the swirling clouds and rugged mountain forms which surround the mountain climbers. At first glance the viewer's eye is drawn to the natural greens, browns and blues of the mountains - then luscious colours such as pale blue, mauve, pink, teal reveal themselves. Above, the blue sky has broken through the clouds, and Varley indicates the brightness of the light by the shadow cast by one of the climbers. Varley communicated his passion for his natural surroundings when he stated "British Columbia is heaven...It trembles within me and pains me with its wonder as when a child I first awakened to the song of the earth...", and in Mountain Climbers, he makes us feel the wonder of being among the mountaintops.
