

As the last living member of the legendary Group of Seven, in the 1980s A.J. Casson was basking in recognition and honour. His work was in museum collections, and he had acquired a dealer, Roberts Gallery - and his exhibitions there were very successful. Casson continued to paint the Ontario countryside, the subject he was best known for and that distinguished his identity in the Group. When asked in 1990 about his favourite location for painting, Casson replied "It depends on different times. I did an awful lot of work up around the Huntsville - Oxtongue Lake, Oxtongue River, into the (Algonquin) Park there." In this glowing woods scene Casson used a selective palette of tones of green and greenish-yellow, with the yellow bringing the impression of sunlight into the scene and creating a strong contrast to the dark evergreens. To emphasize the towering screen of trees, Casson chose the perspective of looking up at them - compelling the viewer to contemplate their stance against the luminous sky.

Frederick Coburn left his village in rural Quebec for Europe in 1889, studying in Berlin, Munich, Paris and Antwerp. Although he returned periodically to Quebec, it was not until 1914 – with the war blocking his return to Antwerp – that he settled in Canada permanently. He opened a studio in Montreal while residing in the town of Upper Melbourne. Coburn soon became one of the quintessential painters of the Canadian landscape. Fine techniques developed in Europe, his affection for the Eastern Townships and its working people along with his sensitivity to light effects merged together into his most indelible image, the horse-drawn sleigh hauling lumber in winter. Hauling Logs has all the classic elements of this subject – blue-shadowed snow, a fine view of open countryside, and the invigorating atmosphere of a bright winter day. It also includes one of Coburn's favourite devices – contrasting a dark with a white horse. With paintings such as Hauling Logs, Coburn distilled the living essence of Quebec's hardy, self-sufficient people working in harmony with nature in a time before mechanization.

Once Frederick Coburn had returned from his studies in Europe, he established his studio in his home town of Upper Melbourne in Quebec in 1914. Coburn had a high regard for Canadian Impressionist painter Maurice Cullen, who influenced him to use the skills he had acquired in Europe to depict the invigorating atmosphere and bright light of Quebec's landscape. Coburn was already pursuing images of the countryside around him, when he had a moment of crystallization gazing out his studio window one winter day. He saw a team of horses hauling a sledge loaded with logs on its way to the nearby sawmill at Kingsbury, and it struck him with such inspiration that activities such as this became a central theme in his work. As Evelyn Coburn relates, "the consummation of all his years of training - the knowledge he had acquired of composition, colour, anatomy and rhythm - was about to manifest itself in paintings that would one day be appreciated nationally and internationally as depicting the very spirit of rural Quebec, the heartland of the Canadian winter."

This work possesses a complete provenance, having been in the family of the artist until now. This is the first time this fine work has been offered for sale.

Romanian-born Sorel Etrog lived in Israel before coming to Canada in 1959. In Toronto he exhibited at Gallery Moos, where he had four successful shows before 1965. He was enthusiastically reviewed by critic John Bentley Mays, who described his works on paper as "exuberant, bold drawings [that] seem to turn slowly and twist in an anytime, anywhere void..." His sculptures can be characterized similarly - their combination of lyrical, energetic lines and hard-edged geometric shapes gives the works both contrast and harmony. Amalgamating elements of the figure and evoking ideas of youth or age, Etrog's sculptures are both surreal and familiar. Odalisque, with its organic knotted form, seems as if it might untwist itself and become a creature of some sort. Etrog's work can be seen in numerous public commissions in Canada, and his Grand Odalisque, which relates somewhat to this smaller-scale work, can be found in two versions in the city of Toronto alone. His work was the subject of a retrospective at the Art Gallery of Ontario in 2013. Etrog passed away in February of this year.

In 1925 Marc-Aurèle Fortin took up residence in Montreal at 351 Notre-Dame Street East, a former hospital, painting in what had been an operating room. Montreal became his prime subject — particularly the harbour, the Jacques Cartier Bridge construction project and the working-class neighbourhood of Hochelaga, in the east end of the city. Fortin discovered this neighbourhood while walking along the railway line beside the river, and from an observation point on a rise, he painted the panoramic view over Hochelaga to the hills beyond numerous times. Fortin was fascinated by the intersection between rural farmland and the city; he found this view so engaging that he was known to visit at dusk and dawn to observe the light. Rising from the city are the striking towers of the Nativité-de-la-Sainte-Vierge Church, Saint-Antoine Cathedral and Saint-François-Xavier Church. With its numerous church spires, details that reflect the life of the neighbourhood - such as the laundry drying in the breeze - and the lofty, billowing clouds Fortin was so well known for, this is a classic Hochelaga watercolour.

Group of Seven artist Edwin Holgate was involved with the Canadian art program during World War II. Already a well known artist at that time, he received permission to sketch the armed forces in Halifax in 1941, and in 1942 sketched shipyard workers in Sorel, Quebec. During that same year he became an advisor for the Canadian War Records Committee, and in 1943 was appointed an official war artist. He was deployed to England, and sketched at Kenley air base in Surrey and Leeming air base in Yorkshire. The Spitfire was a high-performance fighter plane, and many were based at Kenley. As Holgate was not allowed to accompany the air force on their missions, he sketched the activities around the planes on the ground. Airmen Working on Spitfires is a fine example of Holgate's interest in the vital activities of the support crews who maintained these iconic planes.

Works by Holgate from this period are in the collection of the Canadian War Museum, including the 1943 canvas Spitfire at Dawn Readiness and the circa 1943 oil Grooming a Spitfire.

In January of 1914 Jackson moved into the Studio Building in Toronto, sharing space with Tom Thomson. In Jackson's autobiography he relates that Thomson "talked of his beloved Algonquin Park so much that I decided to see it for myself. I arrived there late one night in February [1914] and was met at the railway station by Shannon Fraser, who ran the boarding house on Canoe Lake where Thomson made his headquarters. It was forty-five degrees below zero. Next morning it was milder, only twenty below, so I put on my snowshoes and went off exploring. I saw a patch of spruce woods that looked interesting, but I did not investigate it; a pack of wolves which had killed a deer started howling from the edge of the woods..." This was Jackson's first trip to Algonquin, and the fact that Thomson was already well known in the area provided him with all the connections he needed. Later that same year in September and October, he returned to Algonquin with Thomson for a six-week sketching trip. They traveled by canoe, camping at various lakes and painting. As the season drew on, Jackson wrote, "The maple, the birch and the poplar ran their gamut of colour and finally the tamarac tinted to shimmering gold; falling leaves and snow flurries made us aware that the sketching season was over." Jackson has been documented as returning to Algonquin Park in May of 1941 to appear in the National Film Board's documentary West Wind and much later in July of 1964 to Canoe Lake. However, considering the season depicted and the qualities of the work itself, the painting most likely dates from one of his 1914 trips. Jackson's brush-strokes are fluid, adept and assured, and his keen awareness of colour is in full play in the snow, with its delicate tones of pink, pale green, blue and mauve. It is a fine, fresh sketch executed out-of-doors, capturing the essence of this painting place which was so important to Thomson and members of the Group of Seven.

Fall of 1921 was A.Y. Jackson's first sight of Lake Superior, when he and Lawren Harris continued on to this location after a Group of Seven trip to Algoma. While Harris found inspiration in the lake's vast water views, Jackson was drawn to its shores with their rugged hills and twisting trees. Jackson returned to the area in fall of 1922, and Autumn, Lake Superior is an outstanding example of what drew him while there - solid rock formations are the prime focus, with the lake view behind serving to highlight their strength.

In his autobiography, Jackson wrote of Lake Superior, "I know of no more impressive scenery in Canada for the landscape painter." He extolled the beauty of the country around the lake, stating, "Inland there are intimate little lakes, stretches of muskeg, outcrops of rock...In the autumn the whole country glows with colour; the huckleberry and the pincherry turn crimson, the mountain ash is loaded with red berries, the poplar and the birch turn yellow..." Jackson shows great awareness of patterning in the patches of snow lying in the hollows of the rocks, the dark strips of bark on the bare trees and the fall colours glowing in the ground level vegetation. With its fresh clarity of atmosphere, rich autumn palette and assured brush-strokes, Autumn Lake Superior is a classic Group period work by Jackson.

Franz Johnston painted throughout Ontario, in settings both rural and wild. In the early 1930s, he moved with his family to settled land around Balm Beach, a small farming and resort village near Midland on the shores of Georgian Bay. Here he built a studio and cabins, and taught art in the summers while working on his own painting. He also took many trips to northern Ontario, sketching at and around the fishing camp of his friend Jack McCurdy on Onaman Lake, near Lake Nipigon. Cabins and wilderness camps appeared in his images, as here, with the weathered old structures and splitwood fence. There is a feeling of nostalgia in this work, reinforced by the title, which expresses Johnston's appreciation for this cultivated countryside. The figures by the door of the house add another warm human element. Although it is overcast, the light is strong, and slivers of brilliant bluegreen sky showing through rents in the clouds are a striking colour element in this evocative work.

After Frank Johnston left the Group of Seven in 1924 and formally changed his name to Franz, he continued painting landscape, but decidedly on his own path. His approach to landscape was one with an eye for beauty, cultivated from his early days working in the well-known commercial art firm of Grip Ltd., where influences from Art Nouveau pervaded, with its sinuous lines derived from patterns found in nature.

Johnston was known for his clarity of atmosphere and rich palette. Air Castles, with its cobalt sky and towering cumulus clouds is a gem. The deep blue sky is contrasted with warm tones in the grasses and in the trees turning to autumn colours. The scene seems on the cusp of summer and fall, when the air is crisp but there is still a dreamy atmosphere pervading the countryside.

Cornelius Krieghoff's great skill at creating complex genre scenes is clearly seen in this superb canvas. The native hunters are depicted taking their ease around the fire, under a striking large boulder known as Big Rock. Art historian Russell Harper notes, "One of Krieghoff's greatest series of paintings, large in format, brilliantly coloured, and highly romantic, pictures Indians beside a huge boulder popularly known as the 'Big Rock.'" Such scenes included the realistic and meticulous depiction of native dress and activities, and here he paints the distinctive moccasins, clothing, pipes and rifles of the hunters. Although their poses are natural, and their activity part of their lifestyle, these complex tableau scenes were carefully and artfully composed in the studio.

Krieghoff created a natural stage for the group on the bank of the river backed by Big Rock - an enclosed and protected space. He also placed them in the greater landscape context by including a backdrop of an expansive view out to faraway misty mountains. In this scene is encoded a viewpoint of First Nations people as noble and free, unaffected by the artificialities of civilization, and living at one with the natural world. The bounty of nature is all around them, providing for their needs of food, shelter and clothing, easily taken by using their expert hunting skills. However, the challenges and discomfort of contending with the harsher side of nature were excluded from these romanticized scenes.

Krieghoff was quite familiar with First Nations people, and from 1853 to 1863, when he was residing in Quebec City, met the Hurons at Lorette. Unlike the Mohawks of Caughnawaga, the men of Lorette continued their traditional hunting and trapping, and worked as guides for hunting and fishing parties. Krieghoff snowshoed with Huron guides to Lake St. Charles and was known to be a good hunter and marksman who could always pick up trails in the woods. One of his best friends was a Huron chief who spoke the traditional language of his people.

Not only are paintings such as this fascinating for their depiction of First Nations people in early Canada, they are also virtuoso landscape paintings. Huron Hunters at Big Rock is painted with precise draughtmanship – from the minutiae of leaves and blades of grass to the moss-capped boulder, we perceive Krieghoff's keen observational eye. His colour palette is rich, with glowing autumn hues in the trees, a turquoise sky and blue highlights in the rock. The natural splendour of this wild Quebec landscape is alluring.

One can easily see how such images would have appealed to Krieghoff's primary clients, the anglophone merchants and military men of Montreal and Quebec. While in Quebec City, Krieghoff mixed with well-off English residents; he fished, hunted and caroused with them. He was gregarious in nature and shrewdly practical. The cultivation of his clients allowed him to continue his life as an artist at a time when few others could. Military officers, some from well-known British families, acquired his work as reminders of their life in Canada.

This work is an outstanding example of Krieghoff's tableau paintings of First Nations peoples. Among the impressive collection of Krieghoff works in the Royal Ontario Museum is a similar oil entitled Indian Scouts at Big Rock. Huron Hunters at Big Rock possesses an excellent provenance that can be traced back generations to its original acquisition in Montreal by Theodore Doucet, a contemporary of Krieghoff. This rediscovered painting has been returned to Canada, and as it has remained in the same family, this is the first time it has been offered for sale since its original acquisition by Doucet.

In the early 1950s Jean Paul Lemieux was painting Quebec scenes which, although simplified, had not yet arrived at the extremes of reduction of both landscape and palette that began later in the decade. In 1953 Lemieux was included in a group exhibition at the National Gallery of Canada, and also had his first one-man show at the Palais Montcalm in Quebec City. As Guy Robert indicates, "Landscapes dominated the forty-five or so canvases presented, most of which were painted in the area of Charlevoix and near the Saguenay." In Paysage, Lemieux's palette is rich with colour, with purple tones in the sky and streaks of orange and emerald green running through the warm golden field. Lemieux's brushwork is softly expressionist, and the atmosphere is that of a beautiful and peaceful sun-drenched afternoon.

Daphne Odjig has long been heralded as a prominent First Nations artist in Canada. She is the only female member of the Woodlands School, and is a founder of the Professional Native Indian Artists Incorporation - known as the Indian Group of Seven. While her work is related stylistically to her First Nations peers, using well-defined areas of uniform bright colours, flat planes of space and black outlines, her subjects are quite different. Scenes of family life, motherhood, birth and death form an important aspect of her work. Growing up in Wikwemikong, there were women on the band council and equality was something that was expected. Mother and Child is a strong work from this part of her oeuvre, in which Odjig emphasizes the loving interdependence of the figures by showing them in a warm embrace. The halo-like shape above the mother's head conveys a sense of spirituality and harmony, indicative of Odjig's belief in the strength of family life.

In the 1980s, Jean Paul Riopelle would hunt for wild geese on Anticosti Island in the Gulf of St. Lawrence. At that time, he was living 80 miles north of Montreal in the Laurentians, on a hillside overlooking Lac Masson. Riopelle had a bond with nature that went back to childhood, and through his father he had met the legendary Grey Owl (Archie Belaney, a British man who presented himself as an Iroquois), whose philosophy of respect for nature and rejection of the "horrors of the 20th century" made quite an impression on him. Riopelle produced a suite of prints in 1985 entitled Anticosti, which began with a small abstracted landscape (five years later he returned to the subject, this time reworking it using a sugar aquatint process.) He also used test print pulls from the 1985 Anticosti series as a base for hand-painted works such as this. Exhuding vitality, these Anticosti works are a chronicle of Riopelle's fluid movements between landscape and abstraction at this time.

This work will be included in Volume 7 (1985 - 1989) of Yseult Riopelle's catalogue raisonné on the artist's work.

Goodridge Roberts's interest in still life arose during his time at the Art Students League in New York from 1926 to 1928, when he was taught by Max Weber, who was a great admirer of French modernists Paul Cézanne and Henri Matisse. This subject continued to be an important part of his oeuvre throughout his life. The objects that he chose for his still life works were those from his studio and home, and they were simple yet eloquent. Roberts grew up in an atmosphere of appreciation for literature - his uncle was Sir Charles G.D. Roberts, a poet, and his father was a poet and a novelist. Thus books are often featured in his tableaux, as we see here. Arranged on the table top, which is tipped up to display the objects on its surface, are fruit and wine, communicating the ease of everyday enjoyments. Typical of these works, Roberts used a lush, expressionist brush-stroke and a bright palette, and elements like the emerald floor, red book and blue plate convey a glowing richness. Vibrant and harmonious, this is a classic work from Roberts's still life genre.

In his book on Canadian Impressionism, Paul Duval wrote, "For Albert Robinson, Quebec was a complex of pastel grey, pink, and soft blue villages, homesteads and harbours. His canvases are filled with a luminosity that depends on a generous addition of white paint to his pigments. Only rarely, and then in isolated accents, does he use pure colour. It is not surprising, with white as his signal colour, that the majority of Robinson's compositions represent winter scenes."

Born in Hamilton, Ontario, Albert Henry Robinson was interested in art from the time he was young, gaining a reputation among his schoolmates as the person to call on should they wish to send a beautifully illustrated love note to another classmate. After high school he worked as an illustrator for the Hamilton Times, and soon saved enough money to go overseas and train in Paris, which he did in 1903, studying at the prestigious Académie Julian. From there, Robinson took summer classes in Normandy and Corsica with the American painter Thomas William Marshall, but had to return home after contracting typhoid in 1905. He was hired to teach art in Hamilton, where little was happening in Canadian art. Good fortune brought private benefactors his way when he met Mr. and Mrs. William Davis, who invited him to set up a studio in Montreal. There, he had the opportunity to meet other artists such as William Brymner and Maurice Cullen, who would profoundly influence his life and career. He also met A.Y. Jackson there in 1910, and they developed a quick rapport, planning a trip to France for the following year. This was an exciting time in French art, and in Brittany the influence of Impressionism was all around them. The two Canadians shared the Impressionists' interest in capturing the effects of sunlight, in painting the simple beauty of street scenes and in focusing on the small moments in the daily lives of people. These interests would inform Robinson's work throughout his career, but in France, he ran short of money and was forced to return to Canada once again, just four months after arriving. Back home, he turned his attention to the Canadian scene, and became enamoured of the Quebec landscape. He painted the places outside his door using an impressionistic brush-stroke, setting them in dappled light and infusing them with personal affection. This love of place would last throughout his career, and views such as this one, of Quebec from Levis, would be the mainstay in his work. In them, we see everything through the soft hues of winter's pale light: towns and rivers are painted in the myriad shades of white that only artists living in places with long winters are able to fully and keenly observe. Two sketches for this important work are known - the first, entitled Quebec from Levis, is in the collection of the Art Gallery of Windsor and the other, entitled Quebec, is in the collection of the Art Gallery of Ontario.

In 1955 a retrospective of Robinson's work was mounted. It included a catalogue for which Robert Wakeham Pilot wrote the foreword. Pilot noted, "His canvases and sketches with their subtle and distinguished colour delight us by their gently evocative quality. He is what I like to call a 'painter's painter'. Some critics have linked his name with that of James Wilson Morrice; for both painters have interpreted the landscape of the lower St. Lawrence, seeing in it their own vision of La Nouvelle France."

Jack Shadbolt was influenced in the 1930s by the American and Mexican muralists such as Thomas Hart Benton and Diego Rivera. The emphasis of the muralists on Social Realism and rural values coloured Shadbolt's awareness in works such as this. He was also inspired by their use of solid three-dimensional form, and in Church, Saanich, form is robust and the buildings feel rooted in the landscape. The simplicity of the scene has a directness and honesty, with the inclusion of elements such as the vintage car and the electrical poles. Shadbolt's use of light and shadow is dramatic, with light striking the white church and the path leading to it through the fence, contrasted with the moodiness of the shadows on the road and the clouded sky behind.

The related 1941 drawing entitled Old Church and Car was sold by Heffel on June 25, 2005, as was the related 1947 watercolour entitled Country Church, Saanich on June 17, 2009.

This work is accompanied by a copy of a February 26th, 1973, letter from the artist to Leon Katz in which he dates the painting circa 1936.

Jack Shadbolt writes, in a letter to the consignor in which he reflects upon this work: "How did it come about? Well, yes, I had been doing a few canvases on the undersea theme – something I rarely do and I guess I was in the mood. I did it at my Hornby Island studio. What was intriguing me most about the fish theme was the fluid movement of these darting & swirling red and gold forms in the deep sea–green color of the water. The swarm in the upper left panel was the kind of movement I remember from childhood looking down between the cracks at the pier of the Oak Bay boathouse in Victoria on a sunny afternoon. I was fascinated by these squirming clusters in shining silver. The red-gold part, I guess, came later from watching gold fish in pool[s] – of which I have had several experiences. And a fellow artist had given me a Japanese calendar with big color reproductions of garden fish pools, which they

However I was not thinking of fish when I started the first panel - the groom - on the left. Oddly enough I had been looking at some Navaho headdress in a book - a band around the head - and I guess it was enough to get me started on the white sheet (the work is done on heavy watercolour board). I worked around with some decorative head-like forms (you can still see the Navaho pieces in pale blue zig-zags on black) and then I extended it downward to knock it off the head shape and somehow the configuration suggested a fish shape. I followed this clue and swirled some green water around it and a few other fish forms. By then I liked the fish notion and I set up another panel and started a similar but more decorative form going and invented into it.....Then I got the notion of putting the panels together and connecting up their movement - and then the bride and groom idea hit me because of the white decorative elegance of the right figure - and I thought fish-mouth all rouged up and innocent looking groom and the wedding in [a] swirl of little fish commotion to give it a festive air - and so on.

My works tend to generate themselves as they go along. They are seldom pre-conceived but from out of the act of painting. Not always, but that is my general process. This one is whimsical, at the end of a pleasant summer. Most of the time my images are a little more enigmatic and at times, perhaps, sinister or foreboding. In any case, when I saw the work again, I found it intriguing and it tickled my funny bone as I hope it does yours."

From 1973 until 1980, Takao Tanabe was head of the Art Department and Artist-in-Residence at the Banff School of Fine Arts. During that time, he produced work based on the open spaces of the prairie which explored the edge between abstraction and representation. The work of this Painters Eleven founder was often a wild explosion of colour and form, but Oracle Set #2 is more measured. This however, was not out of character for Harold Town, for as journalist and critic Robert Fulford wrote: "He always pursued parallel careers, as though he was convinced that the world deserved several Harold Towns at once." In his book on Town, David Burnett indicates that in the Set series paintings, the reference is to stage sets. In some of these works, Town used fine patterns of light marks on dark backgrounds, as he does here. Over this two-dimensional patterned surface floats a white circle at the bottom right, whose existence brings awareness and tension to the dark circle in the middle left. Both are encircled by a white line, and they are like cells which may attract, repel or exist in stasis with each other. Town's Oracle Set #2 is a mysterious and charged field, executed with an elegant formality.

From 1926, when Group of Seven artist Frederick Varley arrived in Vancouver to take a teaching position at the Vancouver School of Decorative and Applied Arts, his approach to landscape changed in response to the British Columbia environment. Its mists and moods entered into his work in a poetic way, as he painted views of the North Shore from Jericho Beach, Rice Lake in Lynn Valley or of large inland bodies of water such as Kootenay Lake. Varley was a superb colourist, and Moonlit Solitude exhibits exquisite tones of turquoise and seagreen, clouded with subtle shades of mauve, grey and white applied with fluid brush-strokes. Atmospheric effects dominate, as Varley creates the impression of the soft motion of air and water. Floating through it dreamily is the little boat, reminiscent of B.C. Binning's iconic row boat and man image often seen in his West Coast works, the witness of the beauty of the scene.

Frederick Verner began making trips to the West in 1862, first by laborious modes of transport such as carts, until 1870, when he was invited to travel on the newly completed Canadian Pacific Railway. Studio canvases such as this fine oil would have been produced from Verner's many sketches done on the spot. Verner's depiction of the buffalo was from an idealized, romantic point of view. These monarchs of the plains were a symbol of the raw vitality of the new world; the London Daily News described them as possessing a "singular and terrible beauty". Verner painted them as noble beasts, free and in harmony with their surroundings, as here in Buffalo Grazing, which also exhibits Verner's impressive skill with refined nuances of atmosphere and light. By 1879, the buffalo had been hunted almost to extinction, making Verner's depictions of their existence poignant historical records.

This silkscreen was one of a number of prints produced by the well-known commercial art firm, Sampson and Matthews Limited of Toronto. Some of the reproductions were commissioned by private collectors who wished to have duplicate copies of works in their collections. Many were commissioned by the National Gallery of Canada in Ottawa in a series of "60 Canadian Landscapes for Schools, Offices and Homes." This series was commissioned following an increased demand for fine Canadian works of art and with the realization of the cultural and educational value of fine Canadian paintings. All of the works were "approved for silkscreen reproduction by a committee acting on behalf of Board of Trustees of the National Gallery and composed of A.Y. Jackson...A.J. Casson...and H.O. McCurry..., Director of the National Gallery of Canada." Some were chosen from existing works in museums and art galleries and others were commissioned specifically for this project.
