



Paul Beaulieu traveled to Paris in 1938 and purchased a studio in Montparnasse, painting landscapes, figurative works and still lifes. During the Nazi invasion in 1940, he was interned at Saint-Denis, where, surprisingly, he was still allowed to paint. After his release in 1944 he reinstalled himself in his Paris studio, not returning to Canada until 1973. He was a fine printmaker as well as a painter, and the National Gallery of Canada's collection has three of his still life prints. Beaulieu's still lifes show the influence of Pablo Picasso, as seen in the colourful and vivacious Nature morte, with its modernist approach to a classic subject. In this fine painting, Beaulieu plays with space with verve, twisting and tilting planes, and defining form with sculptural solidity. While in Paris, he continued to show in Canada at the Dominion Gallery, but also internationally in New York, Mexico City and Rio de Janeiro. His work is in international museum collections such as the Bezalel Museum in Jerusalem and the Museum of Modern Art in Paris.

Published in 1948, the Refus global manifesto is a historical document that signaled an important cultural shift in Quebec. In art historian Roald Nasgaard's words, it was "a passionate attack on all the repressive social, political, historical and religious forces that had shaped the Quebecois people." Not only was it the driving force behind the Automatist movement, it is now regarded as a milestone in the modernization of Quebec, exposing the province to the cosmopolitan ideas of the post-war era. The manifesto was written by Paul-Émile Borduas and co-signed by 15 other artists, including Marcel Barbeau, Claude Gauvreau, Marcelle Ferron, Fernand Leduc and Jean Paul Riopelle, who painted the cover art. Besides the manifesto, the publication includes two essays on language and Surrealism by Borduas, three short plays by Gauvreau, an essay on dance by Françoise Sullivan, Bruno Cormier's text on pictorial art, a poem by Leduc and photographs by Maurice Perron. This rare book—only 400 copies were printed—quickly sold out and has been acquired by many institutions, such as Library and Archives Canada and the Montreal Museum of Fine Arts.

This work is accompanied by a set of 7 limited edition Post Canada stamps. Each stamp showcases a work by an Automatist painter (Riopelle, Leduc, Jean-Paul Mousseau, Pierre Gauvreau, Borduas, Ferron and Barbeau). These stamps were made in 1998, to mark the 50 year anniversary of the Refus global.

Jazz music was a critical source of inspiration for Yves Gaucher. Across its dynamic surface, Reflet showcases a variety of brushwork characteristic of Fernand Leduc's Automatist period. Burnt sienna, whites and greys are layered and scraped across the canvas in large, unrestrained horizontal sweeps, punctuated by touches of yellow, red and blue. Swirling streaks of black add rhythm to the overall composition, making our eye dance from one twist to the next. 

Marcel Barbeau's series Combustions originelles is a dazzling manifestation of his radical and expressive approach to abstraction. Painted from 1949 to 1953, and comprised of approximately 350 ink on paper or card works, the series' remarkable range and quality of gestures is emblematic of the experimental nature of Barbeau's art. 





The 36 photographs in this edition were originally SX70 Polaroids. The prints were made by the dye transfer process. Half-tone separation negatives were made using a scanner (a machine which makes an electronic analysis of the original material, allowing for subtle changes within all the negatives). One negative is made for each of three colours: magenta, cyan and yellow. The matrices needed for the final print are made from these separation negatives. The print is assembled by soaking the gelatin matrices in the various dye baths and printing each layer for various lengths of time. The prints were made in collaboration with myself by Nino Mondhe, head of the dye transfer dept., at Creative Colour Laboratories, Hamburg, W. Germany. The edition is limited to 10 hand-painted portfolios each of 9 pages signed and numbered. The 4 images on Page Five were also part of a portfolio of photographs by various photographers produced by Anthony Film Archives of New York in 1982. The paper size in that edition was 15 5/8" x 20" and they were not embossed. The title "Still Living – 4 Acts – Scene 1" and the use of the word "page" are attempts to indicate the merging of textual, painting, sculptural, theatrical and photographic concerns which was the ambition of the work.

BGL is a Quebec City based art collective founded in the late 1990s by Jasmin Bilodeau (1973), Sébastien Giguère (1972) and Nicolas Laverdière (1972) when they were students at Université Laval. Their work is characterized by a humorous approach and multiple levels of meaning, and investigates themes such as consumerism, ecology and memory. Although the scale of their works has steadily increased over the years, their handmade quality has remained. In 2015, BGL represented Canada at the 56th Venice Biennale. Their project, Canadassimo, was comprised of three immersive installations: the Dépanneur (or corner store), the Loft and l'Atelier (the artist's studio). The latter consisted of a roomful of tin cans dripping with multicolored paint and filled with paint brushes. Canadassimo was a watershed moment for the collective, and l'Atelier has now since become iconic of their work. Extrait d'Atelier (Le tabouret) was created in 2016 and is part of a limited series of objects directly inspired by l'Atelier. This rare sculpture surprises us with an incredible accumulation of objects and raises the question: to what kind of artist could this object belong?

Throughout her career, Canadian war artist Molly Lamb Bobak was celebrated for her ability to translate impressions of the fleeting, ordinary lived experience into a dazzling fixed image. In order to capture the ephemerality of large gatherings -a prominent subject of her oeuvre - she first sketched what she saw. Bobak developed this technique early in her career, specifically during her years with the Canadian Women's Army Corps. Bobak's canvases depicting gatherings, notably retain a sketch like quality. In March on Quebec, this is achieved through the loose paint application in the background and the short and layered impasto-like brushstrokes which are prominent in the foreground to depict the roughly drawn faces, devoid of any detail. Together, these artistic techniques infuse the scene with a sense of energy and immediacy.

The viewer is drawn towards the pulsating crowd, made up of a swarm of bold, warm colours, traversing as one through a cool, snowy terrain. Bobak invites us to step a little closer and join the gathering masses. Scholar Michelle Gewurtz notes that, "... Bobak achieved the goal Baudelaire had set for artists in pursuing the idea of modernity: to capture the 'ephemeral, the fugitive, the contingent half of art.' Bobak developed the skills needed to gauge, understand, and appreciate the whole big scene and to comprehend what it is to be modern."





In the still life part of his oeuvre, Tony Scherman has often depicted delectable fruit, but here his image is dominated by a large joint of meat. Works such as this relate to old master still life paintings from previous centuries, of tables piled with game, fish and meat displayed on tablecloths, in which artists showcased their exquisite mastery of technique. Scherman employs the same device, using a pale cloth to show off the foodstuffs and objects on the tabletop. But his work is modern in technique, particularly in its sensuously worked and scored encaustic surfaces, such as the luscious coral-pink background contrasted by green streaks. Regarding his use of this medium, Leah Ollman commented, "The pigmented wax is at once succulent and tough, seeming to vacillate between liquid and solid states. It ripples and furrows, drips in long trails, gathers in gritty crusty patches. Rubbed to the point of abrasion in places, it's glazed to a rich shine in others and occasionally scorched down to the canvas's raw, naked weave." Swooping into the scene is an interloper - a bird desirous of snatching a morsel - creating an intriguing narrative.


