



Heffel is pleased to offer in this auction a selection of paintings by Group of Seven artist A.Y. Jackson from the renowned collection of the Art Gallery of Ontario (AGO). These works are being deaccessioned to benefit the museum's acquisition fund, which will help diversify and broaden its collection. The AGO is known for its notable collection of Canadian Art, and particularly for its extensive holdings of the Group and their contemporaries. Jackson is well represented in their collection, and each of the paintings and oil sketches selected for auction at Heffel has a comparable work still remaining in their collection. These works have never been offered at auction before.

The year 1953 was an important one for Group of Seven painter A.Y. Jackson – a major retrospective of his work was mounted at the Art Gallery of Toronto, and the exhibition put him back in the national spotlight and garnered much praise from a new generation of art critics and artists. Jackson had become the elder statesman, respected as "the hearty outdoorsman, passionate painter, and outspoken champion of Canadian art," as Wayne Larsen wrote.

In Jackson's extensive explorations of his home province of Quebec, he visited the picturesque Gaspé Peninsula (along the south shore of the Saint Lawrence River) numerous times. He visited this area as early as the late 1920s, and in 1929 went on a driving trip there with fellow Group of Seven painter Lawren Harris. In this fine canvas, the last of winter's snow across the hills and fields is melting away, showing bare earth emerging. Jackson's marvelous sense of rhythm in the landscape can be seen here in the curve of the hills, the graceful wave of tree trunks and branches, and the undulation of the ground. Jackson's pastel tones enliven the landscape, from the pink and plum notes in the banks of the hill, pale blues in the snow and shallow pools of water, and the bright sparks of orange at the base of the trees. The sense of the fresh and exciting change of the season is embodied in Jackson's April Day, Ste. Marthe, Gaspé.

In 1911, A.Y. Jackson went on a third trip to Europe, arriving in France on October 5. During 1912, he spent time in Paris and numerous French towns until October, when he traveled to Assisi, Italy, joining his English cousin Will Beck and his friends the Brooke family. Wayne Larsen writes, "Assisi proved to be another fertile ground for Jackson, who spent much time roaming through the hills and painting in the large studio of the Brookes' rented house...the local sites included the thirteenth-century church and monastery that housed many frescoes and paintings devoted to the life of Saint Francis of Assisi, most of which were believed to have been the work of Giotto. Inspired by these hallowed surroundings, he worked day and night." Jackson spent almost two months there before leaving for Venice. The influence of the French Impressionists can be seen in Jackson's luscious use of pastel hues in the high walls of the buildings. Pink, pale green and cream brushwork creates an evocative impression of mottled, eroding surfaces, while architectural details such as the old streetlamps and an arched doorway add atmospheric charm. Assisi is an outstanding canvas from Jackson's inspired time in this historic Italian town.



In the early 1970s, pioneer West Coast modernist Gordon Smith transitioned from hard-edge abstraction into landscape-based painting. In his treatment of form, he was influenced by the work of American Abstract Expressionist artist Richard Diebenkorn, whose landscapes were divided into loose geometric planes. In 1984, after visiting Haida Gwaii, Gordon Smith moved away from his horizontal layered abstracted landscapes and began to use a looser, more gestural style. He also began to use photographs as the basis for his work. This progression in style, and his new practice of using photography was firmly in place by 1985, when he visited Shannon Falls, a striking wilderness site north of his home on Vancouver's North Shore. Smith developed the dramatic image of the falls tumbling down a vertical rock face into a series of paintings, which progressed from an initial realistic approach to a more abstract one, such as we see in S. Falls II. Rock planes, forest vegetation and chunks of cascading water mix together in a spontaneous handling of form. His palette is rich, ranging from deep blues and greens to light silver and pale blues, with notes of orange and brown. Smith's gestural use of paint is exciting in its unfettered approach, capturing the invigorating feeling of this vital wilderness scene.

During World War I, J.W. Beatty was one of the first four official Canadian War Artists appointed by the Canadian War Memorials Fund. The other three were Frederick Varley, Maurice Cullen and Charles Simpson, each of whom were given the rank of captain and full military pay. Maurice Cullen's began to use pastel during his time in Paris around 1892, when he learned the technique from Philippe Roll. He used it to the end of his life and had a great regard for this medium, of which he was a master. Cullen often visited the Laurentians to sketch, considering winter to be the season that held the most beauty, and in the early 1920s built a cabin at Lac Tremblant to immerse himself in the landscape that meant so much to him. One of the great themes of his oeuvre was that of rivers such as the Cache and the North, their dark and mysterious waters flowing through the snow, their edges tinged with ice, their shores ringed with dark evergreens. Cullen did not follow the fractured brush-stroke and fragmentation of colour of the French Impressionists, but instead used pure colours. Cullen's snow is never just white but, as here, tinged with delicate tones of pink, mauve and blue. Particularly exquisite are the strokes of turquoise under the trees, radiantly cool, in this superb Laurentian pastel.

Maurice Cullen, who trained in France at the École nationale de la société des beaux-arts, was one of the earliest artists to bring an Impressionist palette and technique to the Canadian landscape. The forms in many of his early landscapes are bathed in light, and this work is no exception. Indeed, the subject of the work is reflected light – the sunset illuminating the cloud and it, in turn, being reflected in the water of the river. This work is one of many such subjects that Cullen observed on the Cache River in Quebec. As with all of his winter scenes, we can feel the intense chill in the air, and in this case the fact that most of the scene is in shadow intensifies this cold. Cullen is able through the use of atmospheric perspective to give us a clear sense of the depth of the landscape. The use of colour is carefully considered and his tones are deliberately greyed throughout the image, except for the brilliant pink cloud itself and the equally striking reflection in the water. The work is carefully constructed, with the ice breaking up in the foreground to establish our relationship to the scene, the reflection of the trees in the water to join the near and distant shores, a darker right half balancing the lighter left, and the equal areas of bright colour in sky and water balancing each other. The sense of an evanescent moment in nature quickly captured on the canvas is a tribute to Cullen's skills as a landscape painter.



In 1896, James Wilson Morrice was living in France, and during February of that year, he spent time based at the hamlet of Brolles (Bois-le-Rois), while sketching in the forest of Fontainebleau. It was in this forest that the Barbizon artists Camille Corot, Charles F. Daubigny and Théodore Rousseau had worked on landscape paintings. While in Brolles, Morrice would have seen the cottages of the peasant people of the area, the source of his subject. Also in Brolles at the same time as Morrice was Canadian artist Albert Curtis Williamson, who produced a painting entitled A Cold Day based on the same woman, with a similar palette.

In this fine painting, Morrice effectively used a moody palette with close, darkened tonal values; greens infused with ochre and pale chalky plum highlighted by areas of cream. His use of light is masterful – it cuts through the dark interior, striking the woman's face and cape, raking across her pale bowl and illuminating the wall behind her. Le repas de la fermière is a rare and sensitive depiction of this rural peasant woman, and it shows Morrice's empathy for his subject.

In 1933, David Milne left Palgrave and was searching for a new painting place. Traveling by canoe through the Trent Canal-Severn River system, he ultimately discovered Six Mile Lake, at the southern end of Georgian Bay. It was isolated, with no railway or highway connections, and it was a seven-mile trip to civilized contact - but this isolation was pleasing to Milne. He built a cabin on a granite promontory overlooking the lake, and he stayed there until 1939, painting striking wilderness subjects such as Channel Sunset.
