

The Toronto duo of Carole Condé and Karl Beveridge have collaborated with arts communities and unions and their initiatives for over 25 years. Through their photographic works they have served to create a discourse amongst both community and corporate cultures. Originating from their concern with the availability of water worldwide, the artists became interested in the representation of water in art. The Fall of Water was inspired by the fluidity the artists found in the composition and figures in Pieter Bruegel the Elder's masterpiece, The Fall of the Rebel Angels (1562). His depiction of the scene from the Book of Revelation acts as commentary on the local politics of the sixteenth century, and more specifically, the Counter-Reformation. In The Fall of Water, the artists use digital technology to transform Bruegel's Archangels into global activists and champions of water politics, while the figures who have fallen to the base of the photo are the enemies in the fight against water preservation and accessibility. Through their work, Condé and Beveridge represent a global struggle that remains pertinent today.



Ray Mead's career blossomed under the mentorship of artist Hortense Gordon, which led to Mead participating in annual exhibitions at the Art Gallery of Hamilton after 1947 and his involvement in the pivotal group Painters Eleven, formed in 1953 in Toronto.

Mead had settled in Hamilton, Ontario, after his service as a fighter pilot in the Royal Air Force in World War II. His exposure to North American scenery across Canada and the United States was a major source of inspiration, and he derived his horizontal and vertical planes directly from the landscape. Three suspended forms, the focal points of Untitled, show Mead's control of the pictorial composition, while his application of paint displays his development of colour through underpainting—a technique that he cultivated throughout his career. This 1959 oil on canvas, a magnificent work from a period of artistic growth for Mead, demonstrates key qualities that continued to be significant characteristics of works produced later in Mead's career.

Harold Town, who was influenced by American Abstract Expressionist artists, holds an important role in the emergence of modern art in Canada. Along with the artist group Painters Eleven – active from 1953 to 1960 and including artists such as Jack Bush - Town exposed the Canadian public to modernist movements in a conservative art society. The aim of Painters Eleven was not to refute the work of traditionalists, but rather to achieve recognition for abstract artists and their art by doing so collectively, and realizing their potential strength in numbers. Town was successful both critically and financially in the 1950s and 1960s, holding exhibits across Canada and in the USA, and represented Canada at the Venice Biennale in 1956 and 1964. Garden Shrine, created in 1960 – a booming year of creativity for Town – shows his use of oil and Lucite to create many layers on the canvas, allowing viewers to see and feel his painterly actions as he works across the canvas. There is a vivid sense of abstract form, created not just by shape, but by the different brush-strokes and techniques Town used to apply the paint, from thick strokes to thin lines and scratches. Through his unique painterly technique and vivid colours, it is clear that Town was exploring all the possibilities that paint can offer in Garden Shrine.

This painting was executed on William Kurelek's trip to the Arctic in 1968. He was staying as a guest of Terry Ryan who was the director of the Eskimo Co-operative on Baffin Island and Justice of the Peace in the Northwest Territories. The work was one of a series of paintings that recorded Kurelek's impressions of the Arctic and some Inuit legends. In a diary addressed to his wife Jean, Kurelek writes, "Back at the house I worked hard on the smaller square panel showing a round shouldered mountain and bay with a pile of red gasoline drums in the foreground which I just managed to finish after supper before Terry took me to the weekly Eskimo movie. I couldn't miss such a chance to observe an Eskimo community gathering. We walked over and I kept thinking the hall seems on the edge of the town but Terry took me over the brow of the hill it sat on and there was the other half of Cape Dorset in another ravine [...] The hall was long and low. Eskimo families were gathering, the movie would be projected on the back wall which was a dirty off-white. Terry says the distributor keeps sending left-over films to the Eskimos, 20 or 30 years old and they were a series of short slapstick comedies and cowboy films (which these people relish)".
